

Event Assistant (Freelance / Sessional)

November 2025 – May 2026 Approx. 4–5 days per month

Fee / Rate: £15 per hour PAYE / £20 per hour freelance

Location and Frequency: Approximately 2 or 3 event days per month on weekends in East London (mainly Waltham Forest, Barking & Dagenham, Newham, Redbridge, and Havering) plus a half day a week in our Walthamstow office during office hours.

About the Role

The Event Assistant will work alongside Artillery's small team to support the planning and delivery of multiple community events including Repair Cafés, Reuse & Repair Fairs, Yes! Art and Appetite.

You'll help with pre-production tasks, logistics, communications, and event-day delivery. This is a hands-on, varied role that combines practical event support and public facing roles with admin and coordination. It's ideal for someone who's organised, enjoys being part of a busy community environment, and is interested in the arts, creativity, and sustainability.

Key Responsibilities

Pre-production

- Support with scheduling, booking venues, and confirming participants or repairers.
- Prepare event materials, signage, and toolkits.
- Keep contact lists, repair tallies, and project data up to date.
- Assist with marketing tasks e.g. distributing flyers, submitting event listings, and social media posts.



Event Delivery

- Assist with setup and pack down at events.
- Welcome participants, volunteers, artists, and repairers; help the day run smoothly.
- Support data collection, surveys, and photography.
- Be a friendly, proactive point of contact for visitors.

Post-event

- Help compile event summaries including assembling data on e.g. participation, audience, repairs undertaken.
- Upload images and reports to shared drives.
- Support ongoing communication with partners and participants.

Person Specification

We're looking for someone who:

- Has experience of event production especially supporting community, arts, or environmental events (paid or voluntary).
- Has a hands on approach to delivering projects and events a willingness to "muck in" on practical tasks of event delivery with the wider Artillery team.
- Is organised, reliable, and comfortable juggling varied practical and administrative tasks.
- Communicates well with a range of people.
- Is confident with basic digital tools (Google Drive, spreadsheets, email, social media).
- Can work flexibly mostly weekends with event days often on a Saturday or Sunday and possible occasional evenings, plus a half day a week in our Walthamstow office during office hours.
- Shares our values of inclusion, creativity, and sustainability.

It would also be great if you had:

- Experience of creative programming, maker market or art fair curation or similar
- A flair for social media content creation and storytelling
- Understanding of sustainable practices and approaches in the creative sector and event delivery
- A driving licence or ability to help transport materials.
